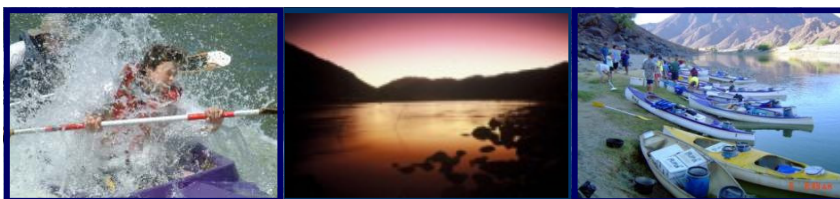
Book and pay for 5 people and the 6th person goes for free!

In order to qualify for the student special students must be in possession of a valid student card and be under the age of 25.



Tailor-made trips to suit your need can be arranged for groups larger than 20. We can accommodate groups ranging to 120 people.

Fitness and paddling experience are not essential as full paddling instruction is given. We use canoes and cover an average distance of 63 km over the three days.

The trip includes:

Including: All equipment – rafts, paddles, lifejacket, barrel/dry bag, cooler box; qualified guides; & meals.

Excluding: Beverages – alcoholic and non-alcoholic; snacks on river.

Transport: To and from our base camp can be arranged prior to departure at an extra cost (ex Cape Town & surrounding areas)

The Orange River

The section of the Orange River we raft was chosen because of its sheer magnificent natural wealth. The Richtersveld National Park semi desert, through which the river runs, is one of the largest mountain deserts in the world.

Over 50% of the plants here are endemic and support fascinating and varied animal and insect life. The banks are lined with willow and ebony trees which provide shade and shelter to river trippers, forming an oasis green band of life through the orange splendour of this semi-desert.

The Fish Eagle shows its majesty as it soars high above the rolling waters while the Goliath Heron with its 6-7 foot wingspan eases its way from the rivers edge. Not to mention the green brilliance of the Malachite Kingfisher as he dives between the river and the trees.

But perhaps the most unique aspect of all is the ability to drift through two billion years of earth time. The arid, mountainous landscape is composed of many varied rock types, which illustrate some of the major geological events which occurred in the Southern Hemisphere over the last two billion years.

Sleeping on the river banks under the stars, and enjoying our scrumptious cuisine, has only ever brought compliments. It is a relaxing, yet awesome trip with a few challenging rapids ... an easygoing tour down an African river.

5 Day Student Special.

Arrival ...

Arrive at our base camp, just across the Namibian border. Our camp manager, will be there to welcome you with a roaring fire. You may want to take a refreshing swim or a game of volleyball after your day of travelling.

Day 1:

We prepare supper that is served at 8pm. We start getting to know each-other around the campfire and 9pm we give a "packing speech". Here we teach and show you how to pack your luggage, liquid refreshments and personal belongings. This is a good time to ask all those questions that has been building about what to expect on river and what about this???? ... and what about that??? Your friendly guide will be more than happy to put all your nerves to rest!

Day 2:

After an early breakfast, your guide will give you a safety talk and equipment demonstration. Here they will teach and show you how to paddle, what to do if you capsize and how to be safe when in a rapid. Before you go onto the river we shall fill you cooler boxes with ice. You'll spend most of the morning drifting and getting the hang of paddling! Your first lunch break on the banks of the river, with the majestic surrounding mountains will take your breath away. We continue downstream until we find a campsite where we can camp for the night. Sleep under the star-lit heavens



Day 3 & 4:

Discover what it's like to wake up in the desert. Later on you may climb up to an abandoned fluorspar mine, where you'll be rewarded with a huge panorama of the Richtersveldt and Orange River as it winds its way through the desert. Each day follows a pattern - languid drifting with the current; hopping in for a swim when you wish; tossing a frisbee; or just lying back and taking it easy. We spend each night at a site of our choice on the banks.

Day 4:

On the last day, well be picked up at the end point between 2 pm and 4 pm. A drive through the semi-desert will return us all to base. After a refreshing swim you can enjoy a few sundowners, while the guides prepare supper. You overnight with us in the camp.

Day 5:

Depart when ready after breakfast.



PASSPORT (this is NB; SA passport holders don't need a visa)

R160.00 per vehicle / R100 per trailer entering Namibia (road taxes – this has to be cash)

Kit List: A guideline on what to bring along:

- Dry Gear:** Warm clothes / t-shirt / windbreaker / sleeping bag / toiletries/ground sheet / tent / Long-sleeved shirt with collar (to keep the sun off) / Windcheater / woollen hat (winter nights) / costume and Shorts / Biodegradable soap (please don't harm the desert) / wet and dry shoes / 6 garbage bags for waterproofing / plate / knife / fork / spoon and plastic mug.
- Wet Gear:** Strops / swimming costume / towel / Kikoi/Sarong (very useful for keeping sun off)
- Accessories:** Camera / sunscreen / lip-ice / sunglasses (must have strap) / hat or cap / personal medication
- Beverages:** Water (2l per person per rafting day) / soft drinks / alcoholic beverages in cans or plastic containers.

We do not allow any glass bottles on river.

Directions from Cape Town

To get to Diepduik, our base camp, take the N7 past Malmesbury. Travel via Springbok to Vioolsdrif. Cross the DF Malan bridge over the Orange River (where you will pass through customs) Two kilometres on, look for the Camel Lodge on your left. Turn in towards the Lodge and right again to travel for about 10kms on the road which runs parallel to the N7 (first 5kms tar, last 5 kms gravel). At this point you will see the RIVER RAFTERS sign on your left. Turn left here down a dirt road leading to our campsite. Our campsite is equipped with a bush kitchen, toilets and showers. You'll sleep beneath a magnificently starry sky - untainted by city lights.

This booking form must be completed on booking and payment of a non-refundable deposit of **R200** per person.
